Tenses refer to the time at which the action indicated by the verb takes place .

1.Present tense - The present tense refers to something that takes place in the present .

a)Simple present tense (S+ V1/V5 +O)

***Used to express regular habitual or repeated action .**

***To express universal truth .**

***To express possession.**

***To express future action .**

Example: We get up at 6 o'clock every day.

The sun rises in the east.

I have a bicycle.

School reopens in June.

b)Present continuous tense (S+is/am/are+V-ing+O)

***It indicates a specific action that is going on at the time of speaking.**

***To indicate future action**

Example: I am reading a book now.

She is going to buy a car.

2.Past tense - The past tense refers to something that took place in the past.

a)Simple past tense (S+V2+O)

***It is used to indicate an action completed in the past at a definite time.**

***It is used to indicate a habitual action in the past.**

Example: I went to Patna yesterday.

They always helped me.

b)Past continuous (S+was/were+V-ing+O)

***It is used to show an action in progress in the past.**

Example: My mother was cooking.

You were flying kite.
