1. Past Tenses [Read the topic and note down in your English Grammar notebook].

If the action was done in the past, it is in the past tense.

Past Tense can be divided into four kinds.

a. Simple Past Tense

Structure: Subject + V2 + object

Eg: I went for a walk.

He went to the market.

b. Past Progressive Tense

Structure: Subject + was/were + V1+ ing + object

Eg: I was going for a walk.

He was going to the market.

c. Past Perfect Tense

Structure: Subject + had + V3 + object

Eg: I had completed my homework before 7p.m.

He had completed his homework yesterday.

d. Past Perfect Progressive Tense.

Structure: Subject + had + been + V1 + ing + object

Eg: I had been walking near the river.

She had been studying for two hours.

2. Future Tense

If the action is to be/will be done in the future, it is in the future tense.

Simple Future Tense

Structure: Subject + shall/will + V1 + object

Eg: I shall do my work by 9 O' Clock.

We will have a party tonight.
