APOSTROPHE


- The apostrophe (') is a punctuation mark used in English writing.
- The apostrophe is used after a noun to show that something belongs to someone or ownership or belong or possession.

Example:- This is Natasha's skirt.

(Here ('s) shows that this skirt belongs to Natasha).



Tom's pencil.



Dev's bicycle.



- A possessive noun always comes before the noun that belongs to it.

- In possessive adjectives we do not use (') mark but the words like -> My, your, his, her, our, their and its shows the possession.

(Here the word their shows the possession.)
