Pronoun- pronoun is a word which is used in place of a noun in a sentence.

Examples :he ,she, it ,they ,we etc

Singular pronouns	Plural pronouns
I, me ,mine ,you ,	We, US ,ours,you,yours
yours	
She ,her, he ,him, it	They, them, theirs

Kinds of pronoun

- 1. Personal pronoun
- 2. Possessive pronoun
- 3. Demonstrative pronoun
- 4. Reflexive pronoun
- 5. Emphatic pronoun
- 6. Interrogative pronoun

Definition

- 1. Personal pronoun- it is used for persons and things. It replaces the proper noun in the sentence I, you, we, he, she, it, etc are personal pronouns.
- 2. Possessive pronoun- it shows possession or' sense of belonging 'of the pronoun in the sentence.

Examples -mine, yours ,ours,his

- a. This bag is mine.
- b. That diary is his.
- 3. Demonstrative pronoun- It points out or demonstrates persons or things.

Examples -this ,that ,these ,those etc

- a. This is my bag.
- b. <u>These</u> are their friends.
- 4. Reflexive pronoun- It reflects the action done by the subject upon itself. It is formed by adding self (for singular numbers) or selves(for plural numbers) to the personal pronoun.
 - a. Rohit is very proud of himself.

b. I planned to do the work myself.
