Topic :pronoun

Pronoun- pronoun is a word which is used in place of a noun in a sentence.

Examples :he ,she, it ,they ,we etc

Singular pronouns	Plural pronouns
I, me ,mine ,you , yours	We, US ,ours,you,yours
She ,her, he ,him, it	They, them, theirs

Kinds of pronoun

1. Personal pronoun
2. Possessive pronoun
3. Demonstrative pronoun
4. Reflexive pronoun
5. Emphatic pronoun
6. Interrogative pronoun

Definition

1. Personal pronoun- it is used for persons and things. It replaces the proper noun in the sentence

I ,you,we, he,she,it, etc are personal pronouns.

2. Possessive pronoun- it shows possession or' sense of belonging 'of the pronoun in the sentence.

Examples -mine, yours ,ours,his

- a. This bag is mine.
- b. That diary is his.

3. Demonstrative pronoun- It points out or demonstrates persons or things.

Examples -this ,that ,these ,those etc

- a. This is my bag.
- b. These are their friends.

4. Reflexive pronoun- It reflects the action done by the subject upon itself. It is formed by adding self

(for singular numbers) or selves(for plural numbers)to the personal pronoun.

- a. Rohit is very proud of himself.

- b. I planned to do the work myself.
